Dear Parents/Guardians:

The fourth round of S.A.P. (School Activity Program) at CMS will begin on Thursday March 17th, 2016. We will be offering the activities listed below to interested students who are on levels 1 to 4 of the CMS PRAISE Program. Students on Level 5 **will not be eligible to participate in the activities and may be asked to leave the school at the end of the instructional day at 2:15 p.m.** These activities will continue until the early May. Please discuss these activities with your son or daughter so that they will be ready to sign-up Thursday March 17th, 2016. Students on Level 1 and 2 of the PRAISE Program will be called down to the library to sign up for their activities first. Students who have their fees (student, sport, library, etc.) up-to-date will be given next priority. Then, in random order, the classes will be called down to also sign up. All activities are on a *first-come-first-served* basis. Activities which fill up quickly *may* be re-offered in the next round which begins early May.

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Two Groups: Mondays and Wednesdays; Tuesdays and Thursdays:
