
Parent/Teacher interviews will not be in person this year. Parent/Teacher interviews at CMS will be held on **Microsoft Teams** or by **phone**.



If the MS Teams is already installed on your device, it will be used it by default.


Parent/Teacher interviews are 10 minutes each. Please make sure to open up the meeting in MS Teams prior to the scheduled time in order not to waste time.
